## 2026-2027 ACADEMIC YEAR ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN ASSOCIATE AND BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMS

### EXAMINATIONS AND SCORE CRITERIA TABLES

- **Placement procedures for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd application periods:** Placement will be conducted with priority given to the results of the Türkiye International Student Admission Exam (TR-YÖS).
- Applications to the programs of the Faculties of Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, and Law may be made based on the **exam and score criteria listed in Table 1.**
- Applications can be made to the programs of the Faculties of Education, Engineering, Architecture, and Veterinary Medicine based on the **exam and score criteria listed in Table 2.**
- Applications to other undergraduate and associate degree programs, excluding the faculties listed in Tables 1 and 2, may be made based on the exam and score criteria listed in Table 3. Applications can be made to the Nutrition and Dietetics, Midwifery, Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation, and Nursing programs of the Faculty of Health Sciences, as well as to the programs of the School of Health Services, using **the exam and score criteria listed in Table 3**, excluding the High School Grade Point Average.
- The university entrance exam scores listed in the tables are valid for two years from the date of the exam. There is no time limit on the validity of high school graduation scores.
- **Applicants applying based on their high school GPA** must have graduated from high school, provide proof of graduation, and have a finalized GPA. Applications submitted based on the high school GPA before graduation will not be accepted. For applicants whose high school GPA is not explicitly stated in the submitted documents, it is calculated by dividing the total of the course grades listed on the graduation certificate by the total number of courses.
- The placement process will be conducted by converting the score types listed in the tables to a scoring system ranging from a minimum of 100 to a maximum of 500.
- The scores listed in the tables represent the minimum admission requirements; however, meeting these requirements does not guarantee admission to the University. Admission and rejection decisions will be made by the International Student Committee based on a comprehensive evaluation of the information and documents submitted by applicants, available quotas, score conversions, and scoring criteria.
